This class is open to teens aged 14 to 18 with parental or guardian permission. Students will fulfill 24 hours of Community Service

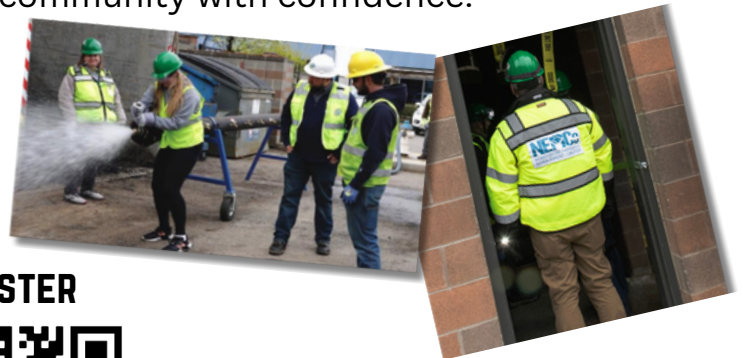


SERVING AN ONGOING NEED...
